MAIN PURPOSE OF ROLE:

To operate as a mobile Combustion Engineer utilising your core skills as a Mechanical Combustion service engineer, reactive fault diagnostics and installations associated to this companies core activities.

Communicate effectively with onsite client and Westway contract manager to provide full

information regarding the work you have completed and any further work that may be required.

Completing electronic engineer's worksheet in full, giving full details of plant that requires additional work.

Completing the Gas Safety Certification along with any relevant legislative or compliance certification worksheet.

Following the required procedures for providing an update for all jobs completed.

Abiding by and working to the lone working procedures.

NATURE OF WORK:

To carry out Planned Preventative Maintenances on behalf of our customers in line with the relevant site specification.

To support the site / customer by attending to reactive breakdowns of the Heating / Hot water, Gas Boiler and Mechanical Plant and rectifying where possible.

To submit detailed electronic reports following any planned or reactive attendance to customer's premises to enable any additional works to be quoted for.

To interact with colleagues, other engineers of the same skill set and alternative skills along with the office admin and management staff.

To liaise with the customer or customer's representative.
